

The Parlor Art Gallery in Paulsen House is featuring an exhibit of artist Michel Campbell's etchings and watercolors during the month of November. A reception for the artist will be held Friday evening, November 16 from 6 until 9 pm. Refreshments will be served.

This exhibit is based on Michel's experiences in Europe, his love of older buildings in Spokane, his family, friends, and various scenes from his travels. The watercolors vibrate with life in their backgrounds and the people inhabiting them. Campbell's etchings are largely figurative and represent sketches he did in cafés and other sites in Europe. His works are compelling in the stories they tell, the drama presented in the vividness of his etchings, and in the watercolors which celebrate everyday life and personal history of another era.
